Alfred University invites applications for a full time – 10 month position of Nurse Practitioner/Physician Assistant. The position is designed to provide primary care to college students independently and in a collaborative and team environment. Under the direction of the administrative director, the clinician provides health services and preventative care to individuals and groups.

- Knowledge:
Comprehensive understanding of advanced nursing and nurse practitioner's care or physician assistant principles, methods, and procedures. Knowledge of uses and effects of medications relevant to college age students, including experience in musculoskeletal, and reproductive care in an ambulatory setting. Awareness of community resources helpful. Computer competence preferred.
- Ability:
To work independently according to established guidelines and protocols. Must be able to establish and maintain working relationships with college students, their parents, Crandall Health Center team, Division of Student Affairs and the Alfred University community.
 - Ability to develop, plan and provide health education programs for group presentations, training, and outreach programs.
 - Self motivated learner and commitment to maintenance/growth of clinical skills, knowledge base and differential diagnosis through continuing education, self-study, and on-site quality assurance activities.
- Skills:
Must possess strong interpersonal, communication and human relations' skills. Exhibit a genuine interest in relating to and serving a college population. Excellent organization ability. Be sensitive to a student's multicultural issues and needs.
- Education:
Registered Nurse with a Master's Degree in Nursing preferred. Must possess valid license as a registered nurse and nurse practitioner in the State of New York; **OR** hold diploma from an American Medical Association approved program in Medical Sciences for Physician Assistants. Hold registration from New York State Board of Medicine as a PA-C. Current CPR certification required.
 - National certification as an advanced practitioner preferred
 - Bachelor Degree required
- Experience:
Three-five years progressive broad work experience in general medicine in an ambulatory setting preferred. Experience in college health desirable.
