- Doctorate in counseling or clinical psychology.
- Licensed-eligible in South Carolina and will consider applicants needing post-doctoral supervision for licensure purposes.
- Experience in working with college population/young adults.
- Strong diagnostic and therapeutic skills with emphasis on short-term treatment interventions and competence/sensitivity in working with a multicultural population.
- Interest/experience with applied research and program evaluation.
- Ability to work within a multidisciplinary setting.

Salary range: \$48,000 - \$52,000 per year.
