

Position Announcement

Medical Director, Ohio University Student Health Service

The Ohio University Student Health Service seeks an innovative, enthusiastic physician to be the new Medical Director for the Student Health Service. The primary focus of the Medical Director will be to provide leadership to the medical service delivery staff for Student Health Service. This includes the oversight of medical service delivery and quality assurance. The medical staff provides more than 25,000 patient visits each year. The Medical Director will provide patient care to students and advise the Student Health Service Director on matters related to the delivery of quality patient care. The Medical Director will serve as campus advisor on matters related to health care, urgent care, risk reduction, community health, and health advocacy.

Responsibilities

- Direct patient care to students on a daily basis.
- Direct the daily medical operations for Student Health Services.
- Supervise and evaluate performance of medical providers.
- Supervise and oversee the work of the nurse practitioners, including mentoring and externships.
- Oversee staffing, including the hiring process, to ensure quality care is provided.
- Create staffing schedule for physician and nurse practitioners.
- Oversee the Occupational health Office.
- Provide guidance and direction for the educational outreach to the Division of Student Affairs and the campus community.
- Supervise the activities of the Quality Assurance Committee, Policy and procedure creation and review.
- Provide ongoing support for the development of the Electronic Health Record.

It is also expected that the Medical Director will keep abreast of the changes in medical practice; changes in, or the introduction of, new State and Federal regulations related to healthcare delivery, Public Health emergencies or notifications, and changes related to qualifications of nurse practitioners, or licensing of other allied health professionals. It is the expectation that the Medical Director will be called upon to represent the university in all matters related to medical issues affecting students, faculty and staff.

Education/Experience

A Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Osteopathy degree and licensure in the State of Ohio are required. DEA registration required. Board Certification/Eligibility in Family Medicine highly preferred. Three years of clinical experience is required. Administrative experience is preferred, specifically related to overseeing the day to day operations of a medical center that included 4 to 10 medical providers, the nursing staff to support the providers, and a variety of ancillary services (e.g. lab, radiology, pharmacy).

Salary and Benefits

The annual salary for this position is competitive and commensurate with experience plus an excellent benefits package, including 100% tuition waiver for self and family; 22 vacation days per year; sick time; support for professional development, and

participation in state retirement system (or approved alternative plan). The salary and terms of this appointment are negotiable.
