This is a half-time position averaging 20 hours a week over 12 months. Position is 90% clinical as a primary care physician and includes care of student athletes and occasional physician coverage of athletic events.

- Completion of medical school with successful completion of primary care residency.
- Licensed to practice or eligible for licensure as a physician in the state of Virginia.

- Some experience as a primary care physician in an outpatient setting.
