

## **Clinical Supervisor of Counseling Services**

Oregon Institute of Technology invites applications for a Clinical Supervisor of Counseling Services. This is a twelve-month, full-time position with benefits scheduled to begin September 1, 2009. This position provides clinical counseling services within the Student Health Center at OIT and clinical supervision of licensed mental health professionals.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Master's degree in Counseling, Psychology, Clinical Psychology, or Social Work related field with supervisory certificate.
- Minimum of five years extensive clinical experience.
- Minimum of three years supervisory experience.
- Licensed as LPC or LCSW with supervisory certificate or licensed psychologist or eligible for licensure within the state of Oregon.
- Competency with differential diagnosis and use of DSM.
- Clinical experience addressing suicide risk assessment and intervention, crisis response and intervention, case management, care coordination and working with high risk/high acuity clients.
- Demonstrated strong clinical skills and interdisciplinary collaboration.
- Demonstrated ability to provide quality and culturally-sensitive clinical services.
- Current knowledge of best practice standards in the mental health field and of life span development issues.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively within a team-oriented environment and strong interpersonal skills.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Outstanding outreach and presentation skills.

### **Preferred Qualifications:**

- Experience providing service to a college student population, preferably within the higher education system.
- Experience in higher education.
- Case management experience.
- Experience or training in: evidence-based practices in college mental health, brief therapy modalities, harm reduction models, co-occurring disorders, drug and alcohol assessment and treatment, self-injurious behaviors, gender identity, anger management, eating disorders, dialectical behavioral therapy, group therapy, community needs assessments and data collection, outreach and prevention program promotion, educational presentations.
