

## **Health Educator - Student Health Services, Texas A&M University**

Texas A&M University has a health educator position available.

As part of a team of health educators, this person develops, implements, and evaluates theory- and evidence-based health education programming focusing on prevention, risk reduction, and health promotion for all TAMU students. Serves as a campus resource for health information. Provides leadership and expertise to build a comprehensive educational program. Networks with campus departments and organizations.

Conducts needs assessments, including the American College Health Association National College Health Assessment, to identify areas of student issues and concerns and develops goals and objectives for interventions. Develops program content, learning resources, and evaluation tools for specific education interventions. Prepares and reviews education materials. Presents health education programs to diverse audiences. Provides individual consultation to students with specific health education needs. Collaborates with other campus resources to ensure accuracy of information and effectiveness of programming. Coordinates information and activities with community resources and serves as a liaison with community agencies as appropriate. Trains and monitors peer educators regarding health information.

Bachelor's degree in health education, public health, health promotion, nutrition or related field. Two years in health education or related fields (can include internships). Computer skills and experience with Microsoft Office required. Requires ability to multi-task and work cooperatively with others. Excellent written and verbal communication and interpersonal skills also required.

Master's Degree strongly preferred. Program development skills strongly preferred. CHES (Certified Health Education Specialist) preferred.
