Tulane University Student Health Service has an opening for a full-time (off July and August) physician to join a team of primary care physicians in its main campus Student Health Center Clinic. Tulane Student Health Service affiliated with the Tulane University academic medical center is a JCAHO accredited health care facility serving students with over twenty-six thousand patient visits per year. The clinic which also houses mental health services is on the campus of Tulane University. The campus is in a wooded area of uptown New Orleans. Staff physicians have faculty appointments in their home departments at the Tulane University School of Medicine.

Qualifications

Board certified in Internal Medicine, Family Medicine or Pediatrics; a subspecialty board in Adolescent Medicine is desirable; strong interest in college age population, and Louisiana medical license required. An interest and skills in women's health care are desirable. Successful candidate will work for a dynamic high quality student health center on an exciting, thriving university campus providing medical care to students in an ambulatory and acute care setting. Interested individuals should have high quality clinical skills, interpersonal skills, be team oriented, and love working with a student/young adult population and their problems and concerns. There is also potential for teaching and clinical involvement at the medical campus. Staff physicians may qualify for clinical faculty appointments.
