

STAFF PSYCHOLOGIST

CAPS (Counseling & Psychological Services) of the University of Mary Washington is seeking a licensed clinical psychologist who is committed to providing creative, collaborative clinical service in a university environment. The successful candidate will be skilled in consultation, brief therapy models, group therapy and in providing innovative, inclusive outreach programming. S/he must be able both to work independently, and cooperatively as a member of a professional team, within the administrative structure of the Division of Student Affairs and the University.

The University of Mary Washington is a selective, state-assisted liberal arts university of ~ 4000 full-time students and is located in Fredericksburg, VA, a growing community noted for its historic significance as well as its proximity to abundant cultural and recreational resources. CAPS supports the University mission by providing clinical, consultative and preventive services to enhance student development and facilitate student learning, personal and academic functioning.

Primary duties:

Intake/clinical assessment; crisis intervention; brief individual psychotherapy; group therapy; consultation with campus and community members; design/presentation of training programs for students/staff; educational outreach programming; program evaluation. This is a ten-month administrative position with a strong, primary emphasis on innovative service delivery. Some evening and weekend hours are expected, especially involving crisis intervention and outreach activities.

Qualifications:

APA-approved Psy.D., Ed.D. or Ph.D. in clinical or counseling psychology. Licensed or license-eligible status in Virginia. Position requires broad, generalist clinical skills, including experience assessing and intervening with a range of disorders, concerns, and degrees of pathology. Brief therapy and group facilitation experience in a college/university counseling center is preferred. Expertise in one or more of the following areas is highly desirable: health psychology, wellness programming, cognitive-behavioral therapy, substance abuse, eating disorders.

The position will commence in mid-August 2009, for the 2009-2010 academic year. Salary and benefits are competitive.
