

The *University of South Florida Counseling Center* invites applications for a 12 month full-time Staff Psychologist position with demonstrated proficiency in providing multi-modal psychotherapy and in conducting diagnostic psychological assessment for a diverse university population. Demonstrated experience conducting community outreach and providing crisis assessment and interventions. Demonstrated experience with a wide range of psychiatric populations, including involuntary hospitalizations. Knowledge of psychological theories of personality, psychopathology and evidence-based models of behavior change. Knowledge of professional guidelines for the training of psychology interns and practicum students, knowledge and interest in applied research on the impact of mental and emotional health on learning potential, academic success and retention. Demonstrated initiative in the development and enhancement of community-based, student-focused, service-driven educational and counseling programs.

Minimum Qualifications: Doctorate in clinical or counseling psychology from an APA-accredited program, and at least one year experience in a college counseling center setting. Eligible for licensure as a psychologist in Florida in accordance with Chapter 490, F.S.\*.

Preferred Qualifications: Doctorate in clinical or counseling psychology from an APA-accredited program, and at least two years experience in a university counseling center setting. Licensed as a psychologist in Florida in accordance with Chapter 490, F.S.\*. Salary range for the full-time position is \$54-\$60,000, commensurate with experience. Initial review of applications will begin on **April 15, 2009** and will continue until the position is filled.
