Essential functions Obtains and evaluates medical, developmental, and mental health history of patients. Performs assessments using various techniques and tools; discriminates between normal and abnormal findings obtained by history, physical examination, screening, and behavioral assessments. Makes diagnoses and implements appropriate evidence-based medical management plans focused on treatment of illness, prevention of illness, and promotion of health. Gathers data on patient problems, compliance with treatment regimens, follow-up, and health status to evaluate practice outcomes. Performs patient teaching on disease conditions, disease prevention, and healthy lifestyles.

Marginal/Incidental functions Other functions as assigned.

Required qualifications Master's degree in Nursing (MSN, MS). 2 years experience as a Nurse Practitioner. Current Texas Registered Nurse (RN) license. National certification as either an adult or family nurse practitioner and recognition as an advanced practice nurse by the Texas Board of Nurse Examiners (BNE). Current prescriptive authorization from BNE. Authorization for prescribing controlled substances III-V and DEA number must be obtained within 30 days of hire. Current basic life support certification. Applicants must include in their online resume the following information: 1) Employment:
