Participate in the overall goals of the organization.

Required qualifications Doctoral degree in Medicine (M.D. or D.O.). At least two (2) years experience in direct patient care. Residency training with board certification in Family Practice or Internal Medicine. Licensed or eligible for licensure to practice medicine in the State of Texas. Certified or eligible for Sports Medicine Certificate of Added Qualification (CAQ). Computer experience. Equivalent combination of relevant education and experience may be substituted as appropriate.

Preferred qualifications At least three (3) years experience working with patients between the ages of 18 and 25. Post-residency experience in sports medicine. Electronic medical record experience.

Working conditions May work around standard office conditions. May work around biohazards. May work around chemicals. Repetitive use of a keyboard at a workstation. Use of manual dexterity. Climbing of stairs.
